

PE Funding Decisions 2018/19

Meeting held on

Mr Salisbury and Mr Abbott met to make the spending decisions for the sum of around £16575 that will be in our budget. Some priorities for spending were identified and other projects already allocated funding were listed.

They are as follows:

£1500 to contribute towards the cost of the Primary School sports programme coordinated by Rosie Thompson at Gillingham School

£25 additional contribution to the partnership for extra costs such as first aid cover at events and medals.

£800 for swimming coach to come for two mornings a week for six weeks in Summer 2015. Teachers work alongside the coach to improve their swimming teaching skills and knowledge.

£1800 Games Coach to come for a six week block in the Autumn term, to work with three classes over a day each week. Alongside this there are periods of planning and evaluation time for teachers to support their teaching of Games.

£600 Club for Younger children in the Spring and Summer terms

£500 Additional sports equipment such as footballs, netballs, physical play equipment for the Early Years children and games equipment for KS1

£800 Attendance at courses, meetings and events

£800 Supply costs for attendance at Festivals and Tournaments

£780 Costs of TA support for Games lessons, to train up specialist TAs and provide more differentiated learning for the children.

£1000 Funding to support the improvements to the school swimming pool.

£400 Subject Leader time to develop further opportunities for all children

£800 Specialist coaching to come in to school during the year.

Total spending so far is £9805 , leaving unallocated
