

English

- Phonics: Reading and writing set 2 digraphs ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, ar, or, ir, air, ou, oy and guided reading.
- Texts: Superkid, Supertato, Superworm, Super duck, Farmer Duck, A Farmer's Life for me, Zog and the Flying Doctors, Going to the Doctors.
- Reading; listening to and discussing story themes, linking to other stories; relating reading to own experiences of farmers, doctors and hospitals.
- Writing: Practising new vocabulary by writing all the sounds heard in words; rehearsing simple story sentences linked to Superkid and Zog; writing factual sentences about being a farmer or a nurse.

History and Geography

- Using basic geographical vocabulary to describe the journey of their superhero.
- Looking at the lives of significant medical individuals from the past; Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell.
- Comparing hospitals from the past with modern hospitals.

PE

- Balancing & co-ordination
- Team games & co-operation
- Agility
- Ball skills: rolling, sending, receiving, controlling, throwing, catching, team games

Maths

- Number - number bonds to ten, introducing part/part/whole models, using bar models to recognise bonds to 10, addition methods and exploring fact families.
- Geometry - shape. Recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes and using them to make patterns and pictures.
- Measurement - Compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights.
